5.4.7 NOMINATIONS COMMITTEE ELECTION PROCESS

Policy

To describe the election process for the Nominations Committee.

Procedure

1. The Nominations Committee will consist of five (5) Members elected at the Annual Convention in the year prior to the provincial elections.
2. The call for nomination for the Nominations Committee will be issued at least eight (8) weeks in advance of the first day of Convention.
3. The close of nominations will occur at least four (4) weeks in advance of the first day of Convention.
4. The Provincial Returning Officer will oversee the Nominations Committee election.
5. The eligible voting list will be composed of the registered delegates, as of 0900 PST, on the first day of the Annual Convention.
 - (a) Any changes to delegate status prior to 0900 PST, will be conveyed to the election vendor upon establishment of the eligible voters list.
 - (b) No additions to the eligible voters list will be made after 0900 PST.
6. The voting will open at noon PST on the first day of the Annual Convention.
7. The voting will close at noon PST on the last day of the Annual Convention.
8. The President will declare elected to office the five (5) candidates who receive the largest number of votes.
9. If there are only five (5) candidates for these positions, the vote will be dispensed with and the President will declare those candidates elected.
